| HeartSaver CPR AED + First Aid | 8 hours | \$480 per class | Yes (2 years) NOTE: Not acceptable for NYSED Coaches, need a Red Cross course to satisfy course length requirements | +\$60 | adult, child and infant CPR (one rescuer), choking skills, pocket mask, AED, first aid including epi-pen and basic splinting |
| Basic Life Support for the Healthcare Provider | 3-4 hours | \$320 per class | Yes (2 years) | +\$40 | adult, child and infant CPR (one and two rescuer), choking skills, mask, AED, BVM |
