CITY OF CORTLAND LITTERING**

**Section 1. Enactment and Title.**

The City Council of the City of Cortland does hereby amend Chapter 181-3 and 181-5 of the City Code.

**Section 2. Authorization, Purpose and Intent.**

The City has determined that it is necessary to modify its present littering statute to include places on private property in plain view of the Public.

**Section 3. § 181-3 Littering of places in plain-view of the Public NEW**

- A. No person shall litter or shall cause the littering of any highway, gutter, curb, sidewalk *or public place or within plain-view of the Public, including but not limited to front-yard<sup>1</sup> space of private property*, of any description and wherever situate, in the City with litter of whatever nature.
- B. Such litter may be placed at the curb for collection and removal, provided it is in covered receptacles, or otherwise guarded from being scattered by the wind.

**§ 181-5 Owners and occupants to keep sidewalks clean NEW**

It is the duty of all owners and occupants of buildings, residences, structures of any nature, and vacant lots to keep the sidewalks adjacent to such premises *including but not limited to the front-yard space of private property within plain-view of the public* clean and free of litter of whatever nature.

**Section 4. Effective Date.**

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the New York Secretary of State in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.

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## City of Cortland Trash Expenses-2016(estimated)

City of Cortland has a bid price of \$156.40(Bert Adam's Disposal) per ton @ 2,000 tons annually (+,-) which is \$312,800

City of Cortland pays the County landfill (directly) at \$60 per ton at 2,000 tons annually=\$120,000 (+\$312,800) subtotal \$432,800

City of Cortland has a one time order of blue bags at a cost of \$71 per case at 650 cases which = \$46,150 Total expenses for 2016 = \$478,950 Expenses

## City of Cortland Trash Revenue

Blue bag sales (large) 136,750 per yr @ \$3 per bag = \$410,250  
Blue bag sales (medium) 24,000 per yr @ \$2 per bag = \$48,000  
Total=\$458,250 Revenue

## Deficit

\$478,950(expenses) - \$458,250(revenue) = - \$20,700(2016)

\$20,700 divided by 160,750 bags sold = \$0.13 increase per bag to balance deficit in 2016

The Bert Adam's bid price for 2017 is \$156.75(an additional \$0.01 increase per bag)

The Bert Adam's bid price for 2018 is \$158.50(an additional \$0.03 increase per bag)

Raising the blue bag fee to \$3.17(Large) and \$2.17(medium) would cover costs through 2018

**NOTE: 2016 Trash and Recycling Budget is set at \$456,300**
