The Cortland Police Department is attempting to identify the male depicted in the attached photographs. He is suspected of entering banks along Interstate 81 in New York and Pennsylvania and stealing money. His MO is to hand a bank teller ten (10) twenty dollar bills and ask for two (2) one hundred dollar bills in exchange. Once he receives the 2 one hundreds, he quickly and discretely replaces one with a ten dollar bill and tells the teller that she made a mistake. He then exchanges the ten dollar bill for another one hundred dollar bill and leaves with the stolen ninety dollars.

The suspect committed his larceny in Cortland at the First Niagara Bank on N. Main Street on September 29, 2011. He attempted a similar larceny at the Alliance Bank on Main Street but was turned away. The suspect has committed similar crimes in Broome County, New York and Scranton, Pennsylvania during the first week of October 2011.

The suspect is described as a black male who is about five foot six, weighs about 130 pounds, and has facial hair.
